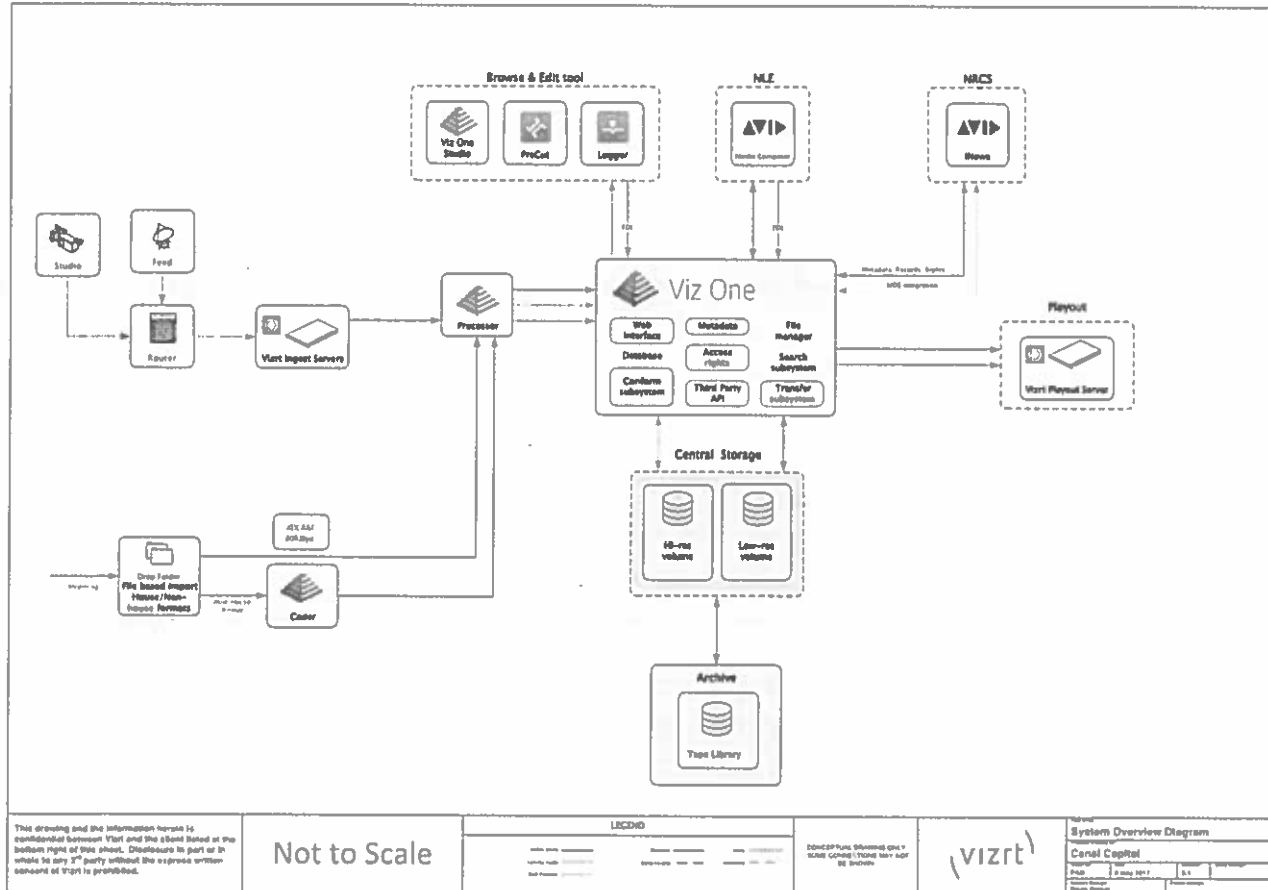

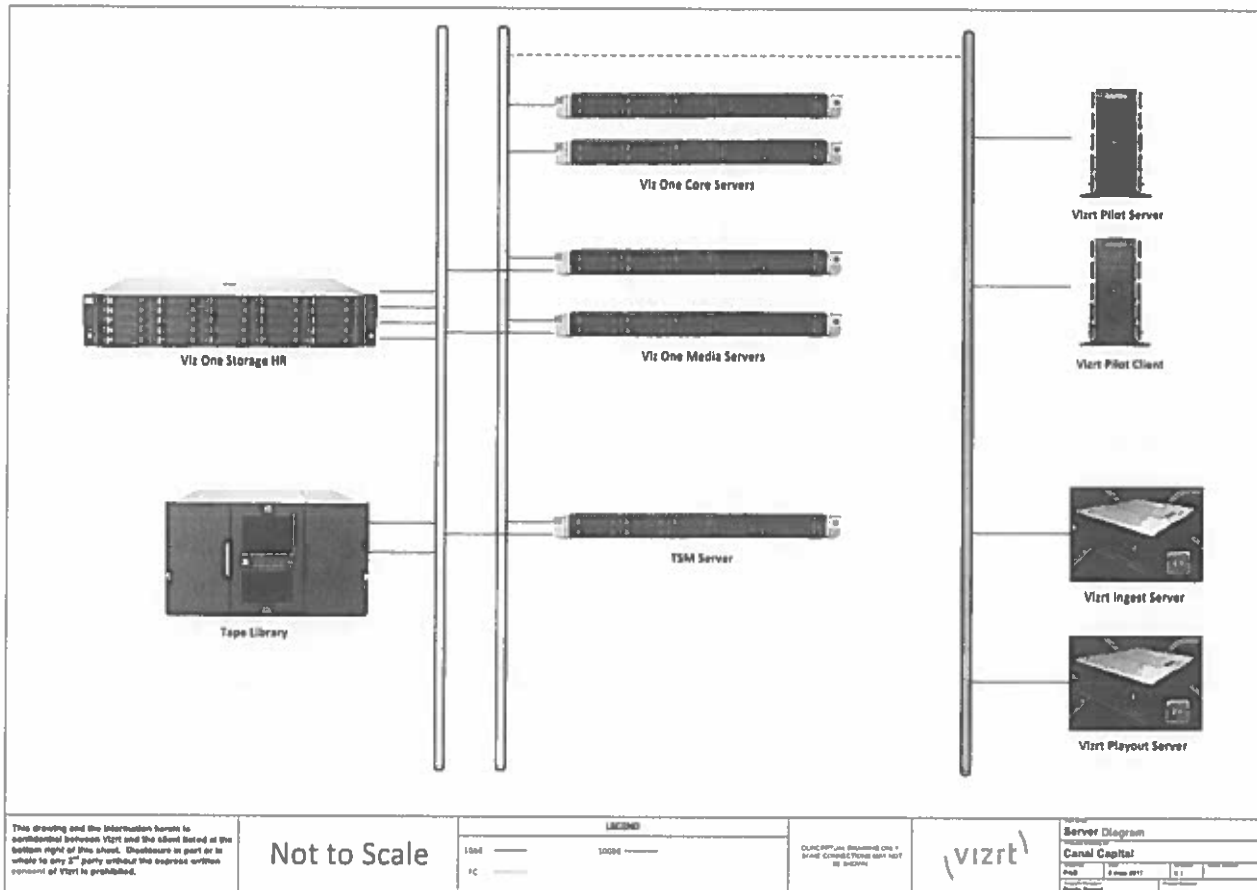

Terms & Conditions - Vizrt

1. DEFINITIONS

In these Terms and Conditions, the following terms shall have the corresponding meaning:

- 1.1. "Customer" shall mean the person or entity ordering, renting or purchasing Vizrt Products from Vizrt identified in the applicable Quotation.
- 1.2. "Price List" means the respective prices for Vizrt Products set out in the price list issued by Vizrt, subject to adjustment by Vizrt from time to time.
- 1.3. "Quotation" means the quotation issued by Vizrt to Customer with respect to the supply of Vizrt Products.
- 1.4. "Vizrt" means the Vizrt entity identified in the applicable Quotation.
- 1.5. "Vizrt Equipment" means any product sold, leased or supplied by Vizrt that is not Vizrt Software.
- 1.6. "Vizrt Products" means Vizrt Software and Vizrt Equipment, as specified in the Quotation.
- 1.7. "Vizrt Software" means any software and support solutions provided by Vizrt to Customer, as specified in the Quotation.
- 1.8. "Terms and Conditions" shall mean these terms and conditions.

2. ORDERS.

- 2.1. These Terms and Conditions apply to all sales and/or lease of Vizrt Products by Vizrt, and shall constitute a binding contract to the exclusion of any other agreement regarding the sale and/or lease of Vizrt Products, including without limitation any terms and conditions of Customer. Acceptance and/or use of any Vizrt Products constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. In the event of any conflict between these Terms and Conditions and any other agreement affixed to a form, order, blank acceptance or counter-offer, these Terms and Conditions shall govern and no other agreement or terms and conditions shall be of force or effect. Vizrt's failure to object to any conflicting agreement or terms and conditions does not constitute acceptance thereof.
- 2.2. All Quotations shall be subject to the provisions of these Terms and Conditions, unless expressly stated otherwise in an applicable Quotation executed by Vizrt and the Customer. Quotations shall detail the Vizrt Products to be purchased or leased, the quantity thereof, the delivery date, lease term, shipping instructions and any other applicable terms and conditions. Standard delivery time is 4 weeks from the date on which Vizrt issues confirmation of the order to the Customer following placement of the order by the Customer, but actual delivery time may vary due to circumstances outside of Vizrt's control and may increase to 12-16 weeks for certain items especially if they are manufactured to order.
- 2.3. Customers may place orders with Vizrt pursuant to Vizrt's standard order procedures, which order shall be subject to these Terms and Conditions and the applicable Quotation. All orders are final. Once an order is placed with Vizrt, Customer may not change, reschedule or cancel any purchase order or part thereof. Alterations to the Vizrt Products that do not change form, fit or function, or changes which Vizrt deems necessary to comply with specifications, changed safety standards or governmental regulations (collectively, "Alterations"), may be made at any time prior to delivery to Customer. Customer acknowledges that Alterations may cause increases in Vizrt's sale and/or lease price for Vizrt Products, and such increase shall become effective upon the implementation of the Alterations. Vizrt shall provide written notice of any such increases to Customer.

3. PRICE AND TERMS OF PAYMENT

- 3.1. Applicable prices for Vizrt Products shall be at the price indicated in Vizrt's order acknowledgment or, in the absence thereof, at the price indicated in a signed Quotation from Vizrt current at the time of the order.
- 3.2. Vizrt shall render its invoice upon shipment of the Vizrt Products. Payment may be in the form of a one-time payment, or a combination of an upfront payment with periodic payments due during the lease period, as may be set out in the signed Quotation. Unless otherwise agreed in writing by Vizrt, where Vizrt has provided credit to Customer the full price for the order shall be paid to Vizrt within 30 days of the date of the invoice. The amount of credit or terms of payment may be changed or credit withdrawn by Vizrt at any time at its discretion. - 4.1. Unless otherwise agreed in writing by Vizrt, any physical deliveries of Vizrt Products shall be Ex Works Vizrt's facility (Incoterms 2010). Customer shall reimburse Vizrt for costs of insurance and transportation on shipments and shall be responsible for all import duties, taxes and any other expenses incurred or licenses or clearances required at port of entry and destination. Vizrt reserves the right to adopt an equitable plan of allocation and to adjust delivery schedules accordingly in the event of shortages. Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the parties, set out in the Quotation or stated otherwise in Vizrt's standard policies, Vizrt shall make Vizrt Software available for download over the Internet by the Customer, in which event all of Vizrt's obligations in respect of the delivery of such Vizrt Software shall be satisfied upon provision to Customer of a functional Internet URL for download of the Vizrt Software.

Customer shall have no interest in any of the leased Vizrt Products other than the use rights described herein or in the Quotation. All leased Vizrt Products shall remain the sole property of Vizrt. Customer shall, at Vizrt's request, and at no charge, promptly affix to such leased Vizrt Products any tags, decals, or plates furnished by Vizrt indicating Vizrt's ownership and Customer shall not permit their removal or concealment. In addition, Customer shall not remove, deface, cover or otherwise interfere with any labels, tags, decals or plates affixed to Vizrt Products, nor permit any third party to do so. Customer shall not sublease any of the leased Vizrt Products or grant any right to the leased Vizrt Products without the prior written consent of Vizrt. No permitted sublease shall relieve Customer of any of its obligations hereunder. Vizrt or its agents shall have free access to the leased Vizrt Products at all reasonable times for the purpose of inspection and for any other purpose contemplated

in these Terms and Conditions. The leased Vizrt Products shall be made available to Vizrt or its agents upon five (5) days' prior written notice by Vizrt. Customer shall at all times keep the leased Vizrt Products in its sole possession and control. The leased Vizrt Products shall not be moved from Customer's site without the prior written consent of Vizrt.

- 4.5 Customer shall use, handle and store the leased Vizrt Products in a professional manner and in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations and the instructions of Vizrt. Customer shall, during the term of these Terms and Conditions and at its expense, keep the leased Vizrt Products in good working order and condition and make all necessary adjustments, repairs, and replacements to such Vizrt Products to ensure they remain in good working order and condition. Customer shall follow Vizrt's instructions regarding repair and/or replacement of the leased Vizrt Products. Vizrt reserves the right to perform repairs or engage third parties to perform the same; *provided, however*, that where the leased Vizrt Products are damaged or malfunction and it is determined that the reason therefor is Customer's failure to use or maintain the leased Vizrt Products in accordance with applicable usage and maintenance instructions, Customer shall pay Vizrt the repair and/or replacement cost within fifteen (15) days of invoice. - 7.2. Customer may not disclose Confidential Information except to those of its employees who have a need to know the Confidential Information and who are subject to written confidentiality obligations no less restrictive than those set forth herein. Information shall not be considered to be confidential if it is in or enters the public domain through no act of Customer. These Terms and Conditions and the contents hereof shall be considered confidential information of Vizrt. The obligations of this Article shall survive any termination or expiration of these Terms and Conditions.

9. VIZRT SOFTWARE

- 9.1. Subject to the terms and conditions set out herein, Customer is granted a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, license to use Vizrt Software in the format provided by Vizrt (whether executable code format or source code format) solely for the purpose and during the term ("Term") specified in the applicable Quotation. Vizrt Software may only be used for Customer's internal business use and not in the operation of a service bureau or for the benefit of any other person or entity.
- 9.2. If Customer's right to use Vizrt Software is limited to specific events as specified in the Quotation ("Events"), then without Vizrt's explicit prior written consent to be given or refused at its sole discretion, Customer's right to use Vizrt Software shall be limited to the extent required for the production of Events that Customer intends to broadcast (via any means or manner, including without limitation, live or delayed; full or in part; by free pay, pay per view, video on demand; digital or analogue; terrestrial, satellite or cable television; HD or SD, 2D or 3D) on its own channels or as otherwise stated in the Quotation. Customer shall not authorize any third party uses of any of the material produced by Customer with Vizrt Software, other than its employees, agents, or sub-contractors, however, Customer shall not be held liable for any unauthorized uses by third parties or any use of the material not made at the direction of Customer.
- 9.3. If Customer's right to use Vizrt Software is limited to specific territories as specified in the Quotation ("Territory"), then while the license for the usage of Vizrt Software by Customer is restricted to the Territory, the clips originally produced based on Vizrt Software and included in Customer's telecasts may be used anywhere in the world, in any manner or media, now known or hereafter devised.
- 9.4. Customer shall not copy, adapt or modify the Vizrt Software, develop or distribute any Vizrt Software or any other works derivative thereof, or use any variation of the Vizrt Software. - 9.5. Title to and ownership of and all proprietary rights, including all intellectual property rights, in and to Vizrt Software, all modifications thereto and derivative works thereof, and related documentation and all partial or complete copies thereof shall at all times remain with Vizrt. As between the parties, Customer hereby acknowledges that Vizrt is the sole owner of all right, title, and interest to all Vizrt Software, all modifications thereto and derivative works thereof, and related documentation, and any intellectual property rights therein. Any feedback Customer provides regarding Vizrt Software shall be and is hereby assigned to Vizrt. Vizrt shall have the right to use any such feedback in any manner in current or future products or services, without further compensation or obligations to Customer.
- 9.6. In addition to any other termination provisions set forth herein, Vizrt may terminate all licenses set forth herein if Customer shall contest or oppose any intellectual property rights associated with the Vizrt Software (including without limitation all modifications thereto and derivative works thereof) or if Customer shall advise or consult with any party engaging in any such contest. Upon any termination hereof, Customer shall cease using the Vizrt Software, all modifications thereto and derivative works thereof, and related documentation and shall promptly return all copies thereof to Vizrt. Customer shall delete all copies of such material in its possession and shall, within 5 days of termination, certify to the foregoing. Vizrt reserves the right to discontinue the operational functionality of any Vizrt Software without notice to Customer where Customer has failed to pay the full price as required.

10. TRADE COMPLIANCE

The Customer hereby acknowledges and agrees that the Vizrt Products, licenses and/or Confidential Information may be subject to applicable export control and trade sanctions laws, regulations, rules and licenses, including without limit those of the U.S., the E.U. and other territories ("Export Control and Sanctions Rules"). The Customer shall comply with the Export Control and Sanctions Rules and agrees that it alone is responsible for ensuring its compliance with Export Control and Sanctions Rules. In particular, but without limit, the Customer will not, and will procure that none of its partners or employees will use, sell, resell, export, re-export, dispose of, disclose or otherwise deal with the Vizrt Products, license and/or Confidential Information, directly or indirectly, to any country, destination or person without first obtaining any required export license or other governmental approval, and completing such formalities as may be required by Export Control and Sanctions Rules. The Customer shall not do anything which would cause Vizrt to be in breach of the Export Control and Sanctions Rules and shall protect, indemnify and hold harmless Vizrt from any fines, losses and liabilities incurred by the Customer as a result of the failure of the Customer to comply with this Clause 10. 12. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

Where Customer is legally resident in a member state of the European Union, these Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales, without resort to provisions thereof regarding the conflict of laws, and the competent courts of London, England shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the parties with regards to these Terms and Conditions. Where Customer is legally resident outside of a member state of the European Union, these Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York, without resort to provisions thereof regarding the conflict of laws, and the competent courts of New York, NY shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the parties with regards to these Terms and Conditions. The Customer irrevocably consents to the personal jurisdiction of the applicable courts detailed above.

13. TERMINATION

- 13.1 Vizrt may terminate these Terms and Conditions upon written notice if Customer materially breaches any obligation hereunder and Customer fails to remedy such breach within 30 days after receiving notice thereof from Vizrt. If such default is remedied to Vizrt's satisfaction during such 30 day notice period and a second default occurs within one (1) year of the original default, the second default shall be deemed not to be curable and Vizrt may terminate these Terms and Conditions upon written notice to Customer.
- 13.2 To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Vizrt may terminate these Terms and Conditions if (i) a receiver is appointed for Customer or its property; (ii) Customer becomes insolvent or unable to pay its debts as they mature or makes an assignment for the benefit of its creditors; (iii) any voluntary proceedings are commenced by or for the Customer under any bankruptcy, insolvency or debtor relief law; (iv) any proceedings are commenced against Customer under any bankruptcy, insolvency or debtor relief law and not dismissed with 30 days, or (v) Customer is liquidated or dissolved.

14. GENERAL

- 14.1 Vizrt shall not be liable for delays or non-fulfillment of its, or its suppliers, obligations under these Terms and Conditions or other losses arising hereunder due directly or indirectly to causes beyond Vizrt's or its suppliers' reasonable control, including, but not limited to, acts of God, acts (including failure to act) of any governmental authority (whether de jure or de facto), official export restrictions, port congestion, wars, insurrection, accidents, disease, fires, floods, labor disputes of any nature, prohibition of foreign exchange transfer, supplier delay or other causes. In the event of any delay or failure excused by this Article, Vizrt shall as soon as reasonably practical notify Customer of the delay, and shall as soon as reasonably practical thereafter specify the revised delivery date. In the event of any such delay, the time of delivery or performance shall be extended for a period equal to the time lost by Vizrt by reason of the delay.

Nothing contained in these Terms and Conditions shall be deemed or construed to create the relationship of principal and agent or of partnership or joint venture, and except as otherwise specifically agreed upon in writing by the parties, neither party shall hold itself out as an agent, legal representative, partner, subsidiary, joint venturer, servant or employee of the other. Neither party nor any officer or employee thereof shall, in any event, have any right collectively or individually, to bind the other party, to make any representations or warranties, to accept service of process, to receive notice or to perform any act or thing on behalf of the other party, except as authorized in writing by such other party in its sole discretion. No clerical error in any documentation relating to any order shall entitle the Customer to reject the Vizrt Products which are the subject of such order. Accordingly, Customer acknowledges and agrees that it is required to obtain a separate use license from MPEG LA prior to any use of AVC/H.264 encoders and/or decoders.

15.2 DigitalGlobe Satellite Imagery
